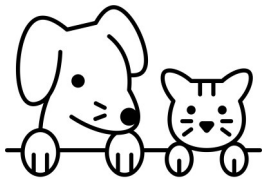


Rose Painted Medallion Calathea



This plant filters pollutants from the air while releasing oxygen. With this plant in your home, you breathe cleaner air.



This plant is considered non-toxic, therefore safe around children and pets.

Goeppertia (formerly Calthea) veitchiana 'Medallion'

- **Use:** This coveted Calathea 'Medallion' boasts stunning painterly patterned leaves, a true beauty. Makes a statement in any home. They are pretty popular due to their large 'medallion' like leaves: a beautiful green pattern on top, and a deep burgundy underneath.
- **Exposure/Soil:** Prefers bright, indirect light. It can tolerate some lower light conditions, but avoid direct sunlight, as it can scorch the leaves. Make sure you don't have chlorine in your water, so using filtered water is best to avoid brown leaf tips. Calathea wants high humidity and high temperatures as well. You can increase humidity by misting the leaves with water, using a humidifier, or placing a tray of water near the plant. Do not use leaf shine and filtered water is best.
- **Growth:** Can grow to 2-3' tall and wide.
- **Hardiness:** Zone 10-12 Houseplant, Annual
- **Foliage:** Large elliptical dark green leaves with light green feathering on the blade of the leaf; between Pink midrib and elliptical creamy white markings close to the margins, red on the underside.
- **Flower:** Not known for flowers.
