Stalactite Plant



Makes a nice houseplant.

Kalanchoe beharensis 'Fang'

- <u>Use</u>: Heat and drought tolerant. Unique plant with multiple "fang" projections on the underside of the heavily pelted, silver, triangular leaves. The leaves are a golden-brown color when grown in the sun or a silvery-gray in the shade and have dark brown spots along the leaf margin and hooked tubercles across the upper half of the backsides of the leaves. These fang-like tubercles, which give the cultivar its name are most noticeable up the upwardly inclined new leaves.
- <u>Exposure/Soil</u>: Full sun. Water weekly allowing soil to dry out in between waterings. Use slow release fertilizer for best results. DO NOT OVERWATER!
- **Growth:** Grows slowly 1-2' tall and 2-3' wide.
- *Hardiness:* 11-12, Annual, houseplant
- Foliage: Velvety, cinnamon/green scalloped foliage tipped brown, undersides of leaves are silvery green with fang like bumps.
- **Flower:** Occasionally will flower and while the pale yellow flowers with red striations are interesting, it is the foliage that makes this plant attractive.
