- <u>Use:</u> Big, bold, and delightfully easy to care for, Philodendron Golden Crocodile is an
 eye-catching houseplant. Its low-maintenance nature means you can be successful
 with it whether it's your first houseplant or your hundredth! It features golden-yellow
 leaves can reach more than 2 feet long and are decorated with tooth-like serrations.
- Exposure/Soil: Grows well in bright indirect light. In lower light the leaves turn a darker green. Too much light or direct sun burns the leaves or causes the deep green color to fade. likes moist but not soggy soil. During the winter, water less often, keeping the soil barely moist. Do not let plant stand in water in saucer either. Feed monthly during the spring, summer, and fall with a water-soluble balanced fertilizer diluted to ½ the recommended strength. Too much plant food causes excess salt build up in the soil and can cause leaf burn.
- <u>Growth:</u> As it matures, the leaves can reach more than 2-4 feet long (but don't worry, it's not a super-fast grower unless your house mimics the tropical Amazon;-). It has stiff stems that are strong and firm enough to keep the plant growing straight up as it matures.
- <u>Hardiness</u>: Zone 11 Annual; Houseplant, must bring inside in the winter or when temps go below 50 degrees.
- **Foliage:** Vibrant neon yellow-green foliage will grow more serrated as it ages. This unique plant boasts long leaves, reaching up to three feet when mature, and showcases striking gold-colored new growth. **Not for consumption.**
- Flower: Unlikely to flower.
