Philodendron 'Ring of Fire'

- **Use:** Looking for a low-maintenance, variegated houseplant? Philodendron Ring of Fire may be for you! This eye-catching variety grows into a gorgeous floor plant that you can enjoy freestanding or grow it on a pole or wall and let it climb.
- **Exposure/Soil:** Grows well in bright indirect light. In lower light the leaves turn a darker green. Too much light or direct sun burns the leaves or causes the deep green color to fade. likes moist but not soggy soil. During the winter, water less often, keeping the soil barely moist. Do not let plant stand in water in saucer either. Feed monthly during the spring, summer, and fall with a water-soluble balanced fertilizer diluted to ½ the recommended strength. Too much plant food causes excess salt build up in the soil and can cause leaf burn.
- **Growth:** As it matures, the leaves can reach more than 2-4 feet long (but don't worry, it's not a super-fast grower unless your house mimics the tropical Amazon ;-). It has stiff stems that are strong and firm enough to keep the plant growing straight up as it matures.
- **Hardiness:** Zone 11 Annual; Houseplant, must bring inside in the winter or when temps go below 50 degrees.
- **Foliage:** Ingeniously toothed leaves captivate with various magnificent colors from orange to brick red and a rich pink to emerald green with white variegation as they mature. Each leaf and specimen of this philodendron hybrid is unique. **Keep away from kids and pets.**
- **Flower:** Unlikely to flower.
