A true gem for collectors and foliage lovers alike. This climbing variety thrives with a support pole and prefers bright, indirect light, warmth, and moderate humidity. Though slower-growing, its bold look and rarity make it well worth the wait!

## *Philodendron 'White Knight'*

- **Use:** Love variegated climbing houseplants? White Knight Philodendron may be for you! This super-trendy, easy-care vine sports dark green leaves irregularly variegated with streaks and splashes of bright white.
- **Exposure/Soil:** Grows well in bright indirect light. In lower light the leaves turn a darker green. Too much light or direct sun burns the leaves so be sure to give them bright, indirect light. Enjoys moist but not soggy soil. During the winter, water less often, keeping the soil barely moist. Do not let plant stand in water in saucer either. Feed monthly during the spring, summer, and fall with a water-soluble balanced fertilizer diluted to ½ the recommended strength. Too much plant food causes excess salt build up in the soil and can cause leaf burn.
- **Growth:** A slow-growing houseplant, it makes for an excellent addition to your favorite desk or tabletop when young. As it matures, Can climb to 6 feet (or more) in time, but a very slow grower so fear not. It will not outgrow your home.
- **Hardiness:** Zone 10-12 Annual; Houseplant, must bring inside in the winter or when temps go below 60 degrees.
- **Foliage:** Features broad green leaves variegated in white and cream, paired with striking burgundy stems. Each leaf will be different with the amount and pattern of variegation.
- **Flower:** Not known for flowers.
