

Variegated Dragon's Tail Rhipidophora



This plant filters pollutants from the air while releasing oxygen. With this plant in your home, you breathe cleaner air.

Rhipidophora decursiva 'Variegata'

- **Use:** A rare and striking plant with marbled variegation and dramatic foliage. As it matures, its leaves grow larger and develop deep splits, creating an exotic, tropical look.
- **Exposure/Soil:** Grows best in filtered bright light. Let the soil dry slightly before watering, and do not water-log the soil or let it sit in a soggy state for long. Mist between watering times, and keep the moss-covered support moist to provide optimal moisture. Use slow release fertilizer. Prefers high humidity over 50%. We recommend you use filtered water on all your houseplants.
- **Growth:** A climbing plant that can grow up to 10 feet tall and requires support as it grows. As a vining plant, its height is highly dependent on support structures like moss poles, which encourage larger, more deeply lobed leaves. This plant can be trained to climb or left to trail down from a basket or shelf.
- **Hardiness:** Zone 10-12; Houseplant, must bring inside in the winter or when temps go below 55 degrees.
- **Foliage:** A glossy green-leaved vining plant with variegation showing both light green and pale speckled variegation on all of its leaves, very faint on the initial leaf. As this plant matures it will develop more splits in the leaves looking similar to a dragon's tail.
- **Flower:** Not known for flowers.
