- **Exposure/Soil:** Low maintenance and can tolerate various lighting conditions, from low to bright indirect light. The more light it gets indoors, the happier it will be. It tolerates low light but looks best in a bright spot. It prefers well-draining soil and infrequent watering, making it an excellent choice for those who want a low-maintenance houseplant. This plant can go several weeks without water. Only water it when the soil dries out completely and be careful not to over-water.
- **Growth:** Slow grower and can grow 3' tall and wide with time.
- **Hardiness:** Zone 10-12 Houseplant, Annual
- **Foliage:** Leaves are thick, succulent, and grow upright. They are bright green with light green mottling and have a pointed tip.
- **Flower:** Not known for flowers.
