This plant filters pollutants from the air while releasing oxygen. With this plant in your home, you breathe cleaner air. Just one plant can efficiently clean 100 square feet of space!

Sansevieria trifasciata 'Laurentii'

- <u>Use</u>: AKA Variegated Snake Plant, Goldband Sansevieria-Drought tolerant and easy to grow. Just be sure not to over water them! Enjoy indoors or outdoors after frost. Bring inside for the winter when temps are below 55 degrees. Adapted to arid environments, the Sansevieria developed CAM photosynthesis, allowing it to open its stoma at night and close it during the day to reduce the loss of water. They are known for removing toxins and purifying the air.
- Exposure/Soil: Water monthly in the winter and 2-3 times per month in the warmer months. Loves shade outdoors or high light indoors, just be sure to ease them into the sun slowly over a couple of weeks each day with more sun as they were grown under shadier conditions if you choose to grow them in sun.
- **Growth:** Slow grower to 3' tall and slowly spreading.
- *Hardiness:* Houseplant, Annual
- **Foliage:** Tall thin leaves with a horizontal pattern of lighter and dark green edged in yellow bands.
- Flower: Not known for flowers.
