

Batik Arrowhead Plant



Syngonium podophyllum 'Batik'

- **Use:** With their heart-shaped foliage, the Arrowhead plant is both subtle and stunning. They look great as a potted or hanging plant. As they are a climbing variety, their leaves gently tumble and drape over the edge of the pot. They are easy to care for and super vigorous, so they are great if you want to fill some space. Syngonium is synonymous with Nephthytis.
- **Exposure/Soil:** Grows well in bright indirect light. In lower light the leaves turn a darker green. Too much light or direct sun burns the leaves or causes the deep green color to fade. likes moist but not soggy soil. During the winter, water less often, keeping the soil barely moist. Do not let plant stand in water in saucer either. Feed monthly during the spring, summer, and fall with a water-soluble balanced fertilizer diluted to 1/2 the recommended strength. Too much plant food causes excess salt build up in the soil and can cause leaf burn.
- **Growth:** A slow-growing houseplant, it makes for an excellent addition to your favorite desk or tabletop when young. Grows to about '2' tall and 3'+wide with age.
- **Hardiness:** Zone 11 Annual; Houseplant, must bring inside in the winter or when temps go below 50 degrees.
- **Foliage:** Broad green leaves are white in the center in a batik pattern.
- **Flower:** None
