

Strawberry Cream Arrowhead Plant



This plant filters pollutants from the air while releasing oxygen. With this plant in your home, you breathe cleaner air.

Syngonium (Nephythis) podophyllum 'Strawberry Cream'

- **Use:** It's a very easy to care for houseplant that will add a pop of color to your home! As they are a climbing variety, their leaves gently tumble and drape over the edge of the pot. Super vigorous, so they are great if you want to fill some space.
- **Exposure/Soil:** Grows well in bright indirect light. In lower light the leaves turn a darker green. Too much light or direct sun burns the leaves or causes the deep green color to fade. likes moist but not soggy soil. During the winter, water less often, keeping the soil barely moist. Do not let plant stand in water in saucer either. Feed monthly during the spring, summer, and fall with a water-soluble balanced fertilizer diluted to ½ the recommended strength. Too much plant food causes excess salt build up in the soil and can cause leaf burn.
- **Growth:** A slow-growing houseplant, it makes for an excellent addition to your favorite desk or tabletop when young. Grows to about '2' tall and 3'+wide with age.
- **Hardiness:** Zone 11 Annual; Houseplant, must bring inside in the winter or when temps go below 50 degrees.
- **Foliage:** Creamy pink and green vining arrowhead shaped leaves.
- **Flower:** Not known for flowers.
