Tradescantia 'Pink Paradise'

- **Use:** Tradescantia Pink Paradise is super easy to care for and quite resilient. Their stems have elongated waxy leaves which get up to 3-4 inches long and are fluorescent pink with splashes of green and cream. In late spring small, light-colored flowers emerge during the active growing season, but it's primarily grown for its beautiful foliage.
- **Exposure/Soil:** Prefers shade outdoors (in summer months), and shelter from hot afternoon sun. Requires moderate water. Indoors they require bright indirect light, and if it doesn't get enough, the colors will fade to green. Make sure to water from the bottom to avoid rotting the stems.
- **Growth:** Reaches 6 to 12 in. tall, with stems hanging 1 to 3 ft.
- **Hardiness:** Zones 9-10 Annual; Houseplant.
- **Foliage:** Deciduous. Colorful, bright pink leaves have attractive silver stripes, and the foliage is smaller and more delicate than other tradescantia varieties. The backs of the leaves are solid pink.
- **Flower:** Small, light-colored flowers emerge during the active growing season, but it's primarily grown for its beautiful foliage.
