Tradescantia fluminensis 'Lavender' ('Lollipop')

- **Use:** With delicate leaves painted in luscious strokes of pink, cream, and green, this charming beauty is sure to draw attention in your home — whether you let the colorful stems cascade across a table or down a shelf. In addition to its visual appeal, the plant is equally winning for its easygoing personality.
- **Exposure/Soil:** Prefers high light indoors or afternoon shade outdoors (in summer months), and shelter from hot afternoon sun. Requires moderate water. Prefers bright, indirect light to maintain its vibrant color; too little light causes colors to fade, while too much direct sun can scorch leaves. Make sure to water under the leaves to avoid rotting the stems.
- **Growth:** Reaches 6 to 12 in. tall, with stems hanging 1 to 3 ft. It has an erect "lollipop" shape when young, becoming more trailing with age.
- **Hardiness:** Zones 9-10 Annual; Houseplant.
- **Foliage:** Deciduous. Green and white striped leaves, often with hints of pink, and purple undersides.
- **Flower:** Small purple-white flowers in the summer, but not as showy as the leaves of this plant.
