

Spotted Flowering Maple



Abutilon megapotamicum 'Variegatum'

- **Use:** Combining an unusual bloom with an unusual color will create new interest in your container gardens and annual plantings. Abutilon (Flowering Maple) has blooms in the shape of a bell with the texture of a paper lantern. The blooming power of this unusual plant will create an oasis of color for the entire summer.
- **Exposure/Soil:** Prefers part sun to shade. Water regularly, when top 3 in. of soil is dry to start. Take care to keep soil moist. Hard to keep watered in full sun, but it is possible.
- **Growth:** Moderate-growing to 4-6 ft. high, 1-2 ft. wide. However with regular light pruning can be kept much smaller.
- **Hardiness:** 8-11 Tender Perennial, Houseplant, Must mulch around the plant and plant in a protected area from winter cold near the home. Or bring indoors in winter for year round.
- **Foliage:** Its gold, mottled leaves and sprawling habit are perfect for baskets or standards.
- **Flower:** This species from Brazil features yellow, dangling flowers suspended from fiery red calyxes.
