- **Use:** This truly striking new introduction is the perfect way to brighten a shady garden. Tall pink flower stalks hold ghostly white flowers that blush as they age above big, deeply lobed leaves sprayed with white. Perfect under the canopies of trees. Flower stalks are good for cutting. A bold and unique accent plant.
- **Exposure/Soil:** Part sun-shade; well-draining soil and appreciates slow release fertilizer. Water when top 3 in of soil is dry. Plants dislike wet soil during the winter months. May be divided or moved in spring, and any root pieces left in the ground will grow into new little plants.
- **Growth:** Quickly reaches 3 ft. tall and wide, flowers reach 4 ft.
- **Hardiness:** Zone 7-10; Perennial
- **Foliage:** Semi-evergreen; Large, deeply lobed shiny green leaves are speckled with white.
- **Flowers:** Pink and cream flower stalks are showy and last throughout the entire summer. Excellent for cutting, fresh or dried.
