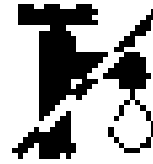


Sassy Summer Sunset Yarrow



Drought tolerant, attracts butterflies, deer resistant, and very easy to grow!



Achillea 'Sassy Summer Sunset'

- **Use:** A tropical twist on traditional yarrow. Its enticing flower-heads begin a warm orange that matures to yellow and pollinators find them absolutely irresistible! Unpalatable to deer and rabbits, It is ideal for pest-plagued landscapes. Despite its towering habit, 'Sunset' is quite durable and its stems are sturdy enough to handle its large blossoms without flopping. It doesn't need much water and performs well even in poor soil, making this yarrow an excellent choice for beginners and chronic "plant killers". Treat your garden to the easy low maintenance beauty of 'Sassy Summer Sunset'!
- **Exposure/Soil:** Full/part sun; Doesn't like much fertilizer. Needs good drainage and can take poor to moderate soils, but avoid clay and rich soils. Requires little to no fertilizer.
- **Growth:** Compact variety of Yarrow with a 3' height and 30" in spread making it a great plant for borders and cutting.
- **Hardiness:** **Zone** 3-9; Perennial
- **Foliage:** Semi-evergreen. Delicate, fern-like leaves produce an airy effect.
- **Flowers:** Large flower heads of dark orange blooms that mature to yellow in summer to fall. Great used as cutflowers.
