

# Desert Eve Terracotta Yarrow



## *Achillea millefolium* 'Desert Eve Terracotta'

- **Use:** A carefree, compact, early-flowering variety with vibrant blooms and ferny foliage. Big, flat clusters of small, sunny yellow flowers. Heat loving, waterwise, fuss-free color for sunny borders or containers. Great color and texture for cut flower arrangements, fresh or dried. Tolerant of heat and drought.
- **Exposure/Soil:** Full/part sun; Water occasionally, until established. Doesn't like much fertilizer.. Once established needs only occasional water.
- **Growth:** Moderate growing; reaches 16 to 20 in. tall, 18 to 24 in. wide.
- **Hardiness:** Zone 4-9; Perennial
- **Foliage:** Deciduous Pleasantly aromatic, semi-evergreen, green-gray fern-like foliage nicely compliments the cheerful flowers.
- **Flowers:** Among the earliest flowering yarrows, it boasts a profusion of large, long-lasting clusters of deep rusty orange flowers from spring until fall frosts. Great for cut flowers.
