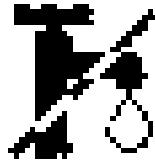


Moonshine Yarrow



Drought tolerant, attracts butterflies, deer resistant, and very easy to grow!

Achillea millefolium 'Moonshine'

- **Use:** A clump forming yarrow with striking silver-green foliage and flat clusters of pleasant yellow flowers from June through September. Deer and rabbit resistant.
- **Exposure/Soil:** Full/part sun; Doesn't like much fertilizer. Needs good drainage and can take poor to moderate soils, but avoid clay and rich soils. Requires little to no fertilizer.
- **Growth:** Compact variety of Yarrow with a 2' height and spread making it a great plant for front borders.
- **Hardiness:** 3-9; Perennial
- **Foliage:** Semi-evergreen.
- **Flowers:** An upright canary-yellow flower that blooms from June through September. The flowers are very long lasting and are wonderful for cutting and drying. Deadhead the flowers for re-bloom and cut back to the basal leaf after bloom has finished.
