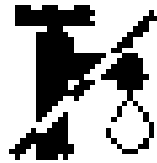


New Vintage Violet Yarrow



Achillea millefolium 'New Vintage Violet'

- **Use:** This compact variety holds its tidy plant habit with a bold, violet red tightly held flowers that keeps its color longer into the summer. Reflowers very well for a Yarrow. Use in borders, rock gardens, herb gardens and in containers. Tolerant of heat and drought.
- **Exposure/Soil:** Full/part sun; Water occasionally, until established. Doesn't like much fertilizer.. Once established needs only occasional water.
- **Growth:** Full sun. Moderate to fast growth to about 12-14" tall and wide.
- **Hardiness:** Zone 4-8b; Perennial
- **Foliage:** Deciduous; Filigreed sweetly compact foliage
- **Flowers:** They keep their colors fresh for months when dried -- and what gorgeous colors they are! The sprays of bold magenta-pink flattened clusters sparkle just begging to be picked! Spring to fall blooms.



Yarrow profusely flowers on sturdy stems, excellent for cut or dried flower arrangements and is an appealing perennial for summer through fall color in your sun-loving garden.
