

Paprika Yarrow



Drought tolerant, attracts butterflies, deer resistant, and very easy to grow!



Achillea millefolium 'Paprika'

- **Use:** Fine textured, fern-like gray-green foliage makes an excellent contrast for the tall blossom heads. A vigorous Achillea with red flowers that keep coming in shades of ruby and salmon rose. The flat flower heads introduce a different shape into the perennial border. Road salt tolerant
- **Exposure/Soil:** Full/part sun; Water occasionally, until established. Doesn't like much fertilizer.. Once established needs only occasional water.
- **Growth:** Grows to 2' tall and 2' +wide. It is a quick spreader and can form large masses if left unchecked.
- **Hardiness:** 3-8; perennial
- **Foliage:** Deciduous. This species has grey-green, ferny leaves that form a low, spreading clump.
- **Flowers:** Lucious apple-red and paprika colored flowers with sulphur yellow centers are among the most beautiful of all yarrows. From early to late summer, tall flower stems are topped with flat heads of these brightly colored blossoms.
