

Achillea millefolium 'Saucy Seduction'

- <u>Use:</u> Saucy Seduction's deep, rose-colored blooms are formed on sturdy, compact plants. The bold flowers are long-lasting and sweetly fragrant. They are beautiful in the landscape. It is a good choice for attracting bees, butterflies and hummingbirds to your yard, but is not particularly attractive to deer who tend to leave it alone in favor of tastier treats.
- <u>Exposure/Soil</u>: Full/part sun; Water occasionally, until established.
 Doesn't like much fertilizer.. Once established needs only occasional water.
- Growth: Grows 18-24" tall and 28-32" wide.
- Hardiness: Zone 3-8; Perennial
- Foliage: Deciduous, fern-like leaves
- Flowers: This intensely colored selection produces a bouquet of flowers that open intense fuchsia pink, then lighten to medium pink. New flowers are produced all summer long, providing an array of cheerful pink color over an extended period of bloom. Great for cut flowers and blooms spring to fall, trim faded flowers for the fastest reblooming.
