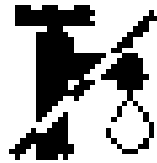


# Summer Berries Yarrow



## *Achillea millefolium* 'Summer Berries'

- **Use:** Delightful range of flower color to this group of aromatic herbs. Leaves are fern-like in shape with delicate fine textured effect. Develops a ground hugging spreading mat that blooms in early summer in stalks about 2 feet tall. Use in borders, rock gardens, herb gardens and in containers. Tolerant of heat and drought.
- **Exposure/Soil:** Full/part sun; Water occasionally, until established. Doesn't like much fertilizer.. Once established needs only occasional water.
- **Growth:** Full sun. Moderate to fast growth to about 12 inches, 2 to 3 feet tall in bloom, spreading to 5 feet wide.
- **Hardiness:** 3-8; perennial
- **Foliage:** Deciduous
- **Flowers:** They keep their colors fresh for months when dried -- and what gorgeous colors they are! This mix includes salmon-apricot/yellow, cherry-red/apricot, white picotee pink/cream, two-tone pink, and many more -- all borne in big 3- to 5-inch clusters just begging to be picked!



**Drought tolerant, attracts butterflies, deer resistant, and very easy to grow!**
