

Marshmallow Yarrow



Achillea ptarmica 'Marshmallow'

- **Use:** Marshmallow Yarrow brings low growing mounds of soft and fluffy white blooms that grow on attractive fern-like leaves from late spring to late summer. This perennial actually blooms the first year and creates a dreamy, romantic presence in borders and front-of-the-garden features. Its drought-tolerant nature and long-lasting blooms make it a gardener's favorite. It is mostly unbothered by both deer and rabbits. Great for borders, containers, cottage gardens, and excellent for fresh or dried arrangements.
- **Exposure/Soil:** Full/part sun; Water occasionally, until established. Doesn't like much fertilizer. Once established needs only occasional water, but make sure they have great drainage.
- **Growth:** Full sun. Moderate to fast growth to about 6-12" tall and 6-12" wide.
- **Hardiness:** Zone 3-9; Perennial After flowering, you can cut it back hard to encourage fresh growth and prevent self-seeding, as it can spread.
- **Foliage:** Deciduous; Filigreed, green, compact foliage is fragrant.
- **Flowers:** This long blooming perennial seems to always be in bloom with gorgeous white blooms. The singular white flowers look similar to Baby's Breath but are much larger. The sprays of pure white clusters sparkle just begging to be picked! Spring to fall blooms.

Yarrow is one of the easiest perennials to grow and is a good choice for beginners. All it needs is full sun and well-drained soil. These plants are an excellent balance of finely textured foliage and bright flower colors.
