

# Coronation Gold Yarrow



## *Achillea x 'Coronation Gold'*

- **Use:** Small, deep yellow flowers in huge clusters on sturdy stems above the silvery gray foliage. Drought resistant plant blends well with western and Mediterranean natives in well-drained soils. Flowers hold color when dried. Deer and rabbit resistant.
- **Exposure/Soil:** Full/part sun; Doesn't like much fertilizer. Needs good drainage and can take poor to moderate soils, but avoid clay and rich soils for best results. Requires little to no fertilizer.
- **Growth:** Moderate to fast growth to 3 ft. tall, 2 ft. wide.
- **Hardiness:** Zone 2-9; Perennial
- **Foliage:** Semi-evergreen. Excellent silvery gray-green fern-like foliage.
- **Flowers:** Golden yellow flowers bloom in summer on flat, upward facing plates. Flowers hold their color when dried. Dead-head the flowers for re-bloom and cut back to the basal leaf after bloom has finished.



**Great when pair with blue flowers such as Salvias. Drought tolerant, attracts butterflies, deer resistant, and very easy to grow!**
