

Dwarf Golden Sweetflag



Very easy to grow!

Acorus gramineus 'Minimus Aureus'

- **Use:** One of the most striking and certainly the cutest of the sweet flags, this dwarf golden form makes a slowly spreading tuft of tiny golden evergreen grass-like foliage. Makes a bright little groundcover in moist areas or as a feature between stepping stones... a real highlight in the woodland garden.
- **Exposure/Soil:** Prefers Part Sun to Light Shade.
- **Growth:** Grows to 3 in. high and 14" wide.
- **Hardiness:** 5-10 perennial.
- **Foliage:** Evergreen.
- **Flower:** Not known for flowers.
