Agapanthus praecox 'Barley Blue'

- <u>Use</u>: Add early color interest to your garden with 'Barley Blue.' This early bloomer will enchant the garden with its light blue flowers and strong stems. Its compact habit makes it a great accent or filler plant for the garden border or mixed container.
- **<u>Exposure/Soil</u>**: Full to part sun. During the summer, be prepared to give them plenty of water. During the winter they prefer well-drained soils.
- **<u>Growth</u>**: Compact, rounded growth of $1\frac{1}{2}-2$ ' tall and $1\frac{1}{2}-2$ ' wide.
- *Hardiness:* Zone 8-11 Perennial; Mulch around plant in the winter.
- *Foliage:* Deciduous. The leaves are long and strap-shaped and look like large amaryllis leaves.
- <u>Flower:</u> Rises above the lush mound of the strappy, deep-green rosettes, and sends off light blue firework flowers. It looks to be shooting off and bursting throughout the garden! This is one the hummingbirds and butterflies will thank you for planting and the flowers are excellent for cutting.
