Agapanthus 'Ever Amethyst'

- **Use:** Has stunning sapphire blue flower heads. These clusters bloom in summer, and are complemented by glossy green strap like foliage. Attracts Birds / Butterflies, Clumping Habit, Cut Flowers, Disease / Pest Resistance, Drought Tolerance, Returns Year After Year
- **Exposure/Soil:** Full to part sun. During the summer, be prepared to give them plenty of water. During the winter they prefer well-drained soils.
- **Growth:** Grows 2-3' H x 1-2' W
- **Hardiness:** Zone 8-11 Perennial; Mulch around plant in the winter.
- **Foliage:** Deciduous. The leaves are long and strap-shaped and look like large amaryllis leaves.
- **Flower:** Amethyst blooms. Blooms open in spring, re-blooming through summer.
