- <u>Use</u>: This early to mid-season bloomer displays full clusters of blue, purple flowers on very sturdy stems. Jonie Blue™ is a compact plant, yet has long enough stems to be used for cut flowers. It's great as a patio plant and also in garden borders.
- **Exposure/Soil:** Full to part sun. During the summer, be prepared to give them plenty of water. During the winter they prefer well-drained soils.
- **Growth**: Grows 2 ft. wide and 2 ft. tall. Flower stalks 3 ft. tall.
- <u>Hardiness</u>: Zone 8-11 Perennial; Mulch around plant in the winter
- <u>Foliage</u>: Deciduous. The leaves are long and strap-shaped and look like large amaryllis leaves.
- Flower: Jonie is true blue in performance and in bloom color with continuous blooms Spring through frost. This is one the hummingbirds and butterflies will thank you for planting and the flowers are excellent for cutting.
