## ***Agapanthus 'Midnight Moon' ('DWAghyb20') PPAF***

- **Use:** Agapanthus Midnight Moon is a striking variety that brings a unique two-tone effect to the landscape. Its deep lavender-blue buds open into elegant white flowers adorned with decorative blue stripes, creating a beautiful two-tone effect. This medium-compact plant is not only visually stunning but also highly resilient. It has excellent disease resistance and is heat, and drought-tolerant. This makes it a perfect choice for gardens, perennial borders, balconies, patios, terraces, coastal gardens, rock gardens and mixed containers.
- **Exposure/Soil:** Full to part sun. During the summer, be prepared to give them plenty of water. During the winter they prefer well-drained soils.
- **Growth:** Grows 24-28" high x 20" wide
- **Hardiness:** Zone 8-11 Perennial; Mulch around plant in the winter.
- **Foliage:** Deciduous. The leaves are long and strap-shaped and look like large amaryllis leaves.
- **Flower:** Exceptionally floriferous, Midnight Moon produces an abundance of dense flower heads, each packed with blooms for an eye-catching spectacle. With a long flowering period and modest re-blooming, it offers extended seasonal interest - lasting even longer than most Agapanthus varieties.
