- **Use:** Agapanthus Poppin' Purple has amazing purple flowers and a high flower count. Poppin' Purple has a long flowering period with good re-bloom so you can enjoy the intense, burgundy flowers for a long time. The tubular, trumpet-shaped, and often fragrant flowers of Agapanthus produce nectar that acts as a great, high-energy food source for hummingbirds. It is a great plant for perennial borders, for in pot on patio or balcony or for in mixed containers.
- **Exposure/Soil:** Full to part sun. During the summer, be prepared to give them plenty of water. During the winter they prefer well-drained soils.
- **Growth:** Grows 2 ft tall and 18" wide.
- **Hardiness:** Zone 8-11 Perennial; Mulch around plant in the winter.
- **Foliage:** Deciduous. The leaves are long and strap-shaped and look like large amaryllis leaves. Resistant to crown rot/ Erwinia.
- **Flower:** Features intense burgundy-purple trumpet-shaped flowers that rise on thick and sturdy stems towering above attractive foliage late spring to fall. This is one the hummingbirds will thank you for planting and the flowers are excellent for cutting.
