Agapanthus praecox orientalis 'Queen Mum'

- **Use:** Has stunning large white and blue dual coloured flower heads. These clusters bloom in summer, and are complemented by glossy green strap like foliage.
- **Exposure/Soil:** Full to part sun. During the summer, be prepared to give them plenty of water. During the winter they prefer well-drained soils.
- **Growth:** Grows 2 ft. wide and 2 ft. tall. Flower stalks 3 to 4 ft. tall.
- **Hardiness:** Zone 8-11 Perennial; Mulch around plant in the winter.
- **Foliage:** Deciduous. The leaves are long and strap-shaped and look like large amaryllis leaves.
- **Flower:** Clouds of white flowers with blue bases float over lush dark-green foliage June through July.
