

# Straight A® Shona™ Agapanthus

## *Agapanthus praecox 'Shona' PP31887*

- **Use:** Agapanthus 'Shona' is an early and heavy bloomer, displaying clusters of bright white flowers. The numerous, sturdy flower stems create a mass bloom display for early color interest with a pure, clean appearance. Easy to grow and little to no maintenance once established.
- **Exposure/Soil:** Full to part sun. During the summer, be prepared to give them plenty of water. During the winter they prefer well-drained soils.
- **Growth:** Grows in a mounded shape 2–2½' tall x 2–2½' wide.
- **Hardiness:** Zone 8-11 Perennial; Mulch around plant in the winter.
- **Foliage:** Deciduous. The leaves are long and strap-shaped and look like large amaryllis leaves.
- **Flower:** White flower clusters on tall stems vigorously burst like twinkling sparklers on the 4th of July above mounds of strap-like foliage summer to fall. The flowers are excellent for cutting.
