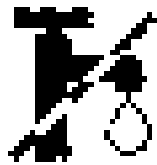


Kudos Ambrosia Hyssop

Agastache 'Kudos Ambrosia'

- **Use:** Cheerful, carefree, summer-long color for beds, borders or containers. This prolific new compact hybrid has impeccable habit, increased hardiness, disease resistance and tolerance of wet, cold soils! Low, tight mounds perform as a filler in containers or are lovely as a mass garden planting. Flower spikes loved by hummingbirds and butterflies, yet ignored by deer and rabbits.
- **Exposure/Soil:** In full sun and well-drained soil, they happily shrug off both summer heat and early frosts. Use slow release or water soluble fertilizer. Keep soil moist watering under leaves and flowers.
- **Growth:** Full, well branched plants grow 17-22" tall & 16" wide.
- **Hardiness:** **Zone** 5-10 perennial. Very heat tolerant! Mulch around plant in the winter.
- **Foliage:** Deciduous; Touch the foliage and scents of licorice, root beer or mint fill the air on these grey-green leaves.
- **Flower:** Creamy coconut, pale orange and light rose pink spikes have a charming, airy appearance. Flower colors change constantly, blending well with almost any color in the spectrum. Nonstop blooms late spring-fall. Prune often for a fresh flush of blooms.
