

Little Adder Hyssop



Drought tolerant, deer resistant, and attracts butterflies! Seed loved by goldfinches. Licorice-scented foliage with a bonus – it is not favored by deer. Scented foliage is good for flavoring drinks and drying.



Agastache rugosa 'Little Adder'

- **Use:** A showy, compact perennial with plumes of rich purple flowers that attract hummingbirds all summer long. Enjoy the mint-scented foliage and profusion of color in sunny borders, mixed beds and containers. Water wise, heat-loving, and deer-resistant.
- **Exposure/Soil:** They should be grown in well-drained soil in full sun. The better the drainage the happier the hyssop. Use slow release or water soluble fertilizer. Keep soil moist watering under leaves and flowers.
- **Growth:** Full, well branched plants grow 1-2' tall and 1-2' wide.
- **Hardiness:** Zone 5-9 Perennial. Very heat tolerant! Mulch around plant in the winter.
- **Foliage:** Deciduous Greenish-gray, fragrant mint scented foliage.
- **Flower:** Enjoy the entourage of hummingbirds, butterflies and bumblebees that stop to savor nectar from the upright smoky lavender-blue spikes of tubular flowers from late spring to fall.
