

# Peachie Keen Hyssop



## *Agastache 'Peachie Keen'*

- **Use:** Cheerful, carefree, summer-long color for beds, borders or containers. This prolific new compact hybrid has impeccable habit, increased hardiness, disease resistance and tolerance of wet, cold soils! Golden flower spikes loved by hummingbirds and butterflies, yet ignored by deer and rabbits.
- **Exposure/Soil:** In full sun and well-drained soil, they happily shrug off both summer heat and early frosts. Use slow release or water soluble fertilizer. Keep soil moist watering under leaves and flowers.
- **Growth:** Full, well branched plants grow 17-20" tall & wide.
- **Hardiness:** **Zone** 5-10 perennial. Very heat tolerant! Mulch around plant in the winter.
- **Foliage:** Deciduous; Touch the foliage and scents of licorice, root beer or mint fill the air on these grey-green leaves.
- **Flower:** bears loads of apricot peach flowers with complementary purplish pink calyxes just at the top of the foliage for a neatly proportional look. Because the calyxes are so colorful, this plant continues to look like it is blooming long after it is finished. Blooms late spring to fall frosts.
