

# Poquito Orange Hyssop



## *Agastache 'Poquito Orange'*

- **Use:** Poquito means little bit in Spanish and this diminutive cutie fits the bill. Let your garden fiesta begin as the showy clear-orange flowers warrant a celebration. Aromatic foliage, long blooming and deer resistant! Enjoy watching hummingbirds and butterflies flutter through the abundant Hyssop blossoms. Drought tolerant, Agastache Poquito™ Orange is an appealing perennial for summer through fall color in a sun-loving garden.
- **Exposure/Soil:** In full sun and well-drained soil, they happily shrug off both summer heat and early frosts. Use slow release or water soluble fertilizer. Keep soil moist watering under leaves and flowers.
- **Growth:** Full, well branched plants grow 12– 15” tall and 16-18” wide.
- **Hardiness:** **Zone** 5-10 perennial. Very heat tolerant! Mulch around plant in the winter.
- **Foliage:** Deciduous; Touch the foliage and scents of licorice, root beer or mint fill the air on these grey-green leaves.
- **Flower:** In mid-summer to fall hummingbirds are drawn like magnets to the multiple spikes Its salmon-toned blooms are breathtaking and its foliage is both attractive and pleasingly fragrant. This exquisite native perennial is a gem for sunny, pollinator friendly gardens.

This is one of the easiest perennials to grow; it is drought tolerant, deer resistant, and attracts butterflies and hummingbirds like crazy.
