

# Rosie Posie Hyssop



## *Agastache 'Rosie Posie'*

- **Use:** Mint-scented leaves may be added fresh or dry to enhance your favorite tea. Cut back flower stems in summer to promote continuous bloom. Hummingbird Mint is an appealing perennial for summer through fall color in a sun-loving garden. It will be a magnet for pollinators from late spring until fall, yet ignored by deer and rabbits. They are equally good in the border and as a candidate for container growing. The better the drainage, the happier the plant. Scented foliage is good for flavoring drinks and drying. A customer advises us that her Goldfinches are wild for Agastache seed.
- **Exposure/Soil:** In full sun and well-drained soil, they happily shrug off both summer heat and early frosts. Use slow release or water soluble fertilizer. Keep soil moist watering under leaves and flowers.
- **Growth:** Full, well branched plants grow 16" tall and 18-24" wide.
- **Hardiness:** **Zone** 6-9; Perennial. Very heat tolerant! Mulch around plant in the winter.
- **Foliage:** Deciduous; Touch the foliage and scents of licorice, root beer or mint fill the air on these grey-green leaves.
- **Flower:** The colorful magenta-purple calyxes remain after flowering giving the appearance it is still in bloom. Intensely fragrant foliage. Can also be used as a cut flower. Blooms late spring to fall frosts.
