Agastache 'Sunrise Violet'

- <u>Use:</u> Lush violet wands entice butterflies and bees by the score with their sweet honey-licorice scent. Blooming from summer through fall, this very disease-resistant and vigorous hummingbird-mint is also quite hardy. Whether used in containers or as a component of the midborder, this beauty belongs in everyone's garden! It will be a magnet for pollinators from late spring until fall, yet ignored by deer and rabbits.
- <u>Exposure/Soil</u>: In full sun and well-drained soil, they happily shrug off both summer heat and early frosts. Use slow release or water soluble fertilizer. Keep soil moist watering under leaves and flowers.
- **<u>Growth</u>**: Full, well branched plants grow 18-24" tall & wide.
- *Hardiness: Zone* 5a-10 perennial. Very heat tolerant! Mulch around plant in the winter.
- *Foliage:* Deciduous; Touch the foliage and scents of licorice, root beer or mint fill the air on these grey-green leaves.
- <u>Flower:</u> Produce beautiful violet colored flowers on upright spikes that are held above mounds of green foliage. Flowers continuously from early spring until the first fall frost. Can also be used as a cut flower.
