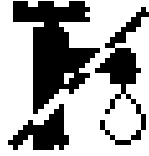


# Blue Agave



## Agave 'Blue'

- Looks lovely in rock gardens, near stacked stone, and in pots.
- **Use:** Beautiful blue foliage makes this plant very attractive. Be careful around this plant because it has spines around the edges of each leaf and a heavy spike at the tip. It makes a dramatic focal point in any landscape and is hardy down to 15°F. They are also very salt tolerant and are excellent for beachside landscapes also! Once the main plant blooms it will perish and live on through the “babies”. This beautiful, yet tough and drought tolerant plant is an elegant choice for sunny, dry gardens and well-suited to containers.
  - **Exposure/Soil:** Full sun. Water every 10 days to weeks allowing soil to dry out in between waterings. Use slow release fertilizer for best results. Do not plant in low lying areas . Drainage is of utmost importance. Sandy soil a must.
  - **Growth:** Grows 6-8' tall and 4-6' wide, larger over long periods of time.
  - **Hardiness:** Zone 8-11, Perennial (hardy to 15 degrees, will need winter protection)
  - **Foliage:** Evergreen; 1-1 1/2 inch wide blue-green leaves that have sharp tips and spines.
  - **Flower:** Blooms only once every 10 years.
