

# Catlin's Giant Bugleweed



## *Ajuga reptans* 'Catlin's Giant'

- **Use:** Catlin's Giant' is twice the size (and has twice the impact) of most other Ajugas. Its deep blue flower spires rise 12 in. above large, shiny bronze leaves. Let this one loose in a rock garden,
- Attractive ground cover with colorful foliage and spikes of blue flowers in spring. They are a knock out in patio pots, combos, and as a striking accent with white, gold or light-colored plants.
- **Exposure/Soil:** Prefers part sun to shade. Use slow release or water soluble fertilizer. Keep soil moist watering under leaves and flowers for best results.
- **Growth:** Fast growing to 12" tall and wide, and keeps spreading.
- **Hardiness:** Zones 4-9; Perennial. Very easy to grow!
- **Foliage:** Has dark foliage with gorgeously scalloped leaves. Many winters it will be evergreen, but in a cold winter may go dormant.
- **Flower:** Spikes of small blue flowers in late spring.

A great ground- cover  
for shady areas.
