

Blueberry Muffin Ajuga / Bugleweed



Ajuga reptans 'Blueberry Muffin'

- **Use:** This fast growing vigorous groundcover is covered with deep blue flowers produced on eight-inch spikes. Blueberry Muffin is a faster, stronger grower than other Ajugas, with thicker leaves that are more weather resistant. Bugleweeds are a knock out in patio pots, combos, and as a striking accent with white, gold or light-colored plants.
- **Exposure/Soil:** Will do best in a shaded area but will adapt to morning sun. (The foliage colors will be more vivid with morning sun.) It prefers moist soil with a good drainage but will tolerate moderately dry areas. Do avoid soggy conditions.
- **Growth:** Will reach 6 inches tall, up to 28 inches wide.
- **Hardiness:** Zone 5-9; Perennial. Very easy to grow!
- **Foliage:** An extremely vigorous small-leaved groundcover with dark new leaves.
- **Flower:** Blueberry blue spikes in late spring.

Fast growing ground-cover for shade.
