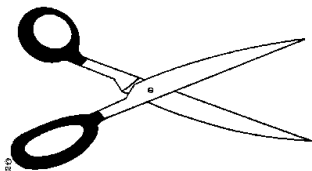
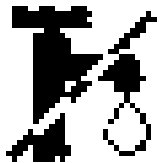


Powderpuff Mix Hollyhocks

Alcea rosea 'Powderpuff Mix'

- **Use:** An ideal flower to grow to rejuvenate any tired garden into a stunning and vibrant winner. These hollyhocks will be bursting with classic 3-4 inch heads in shades of yellow, fuchsia, red, pink, rose, and magenta. An essential eye-catching addition to show off in the back of the garden, a fence, or any wide open spaces. Will vigorously reseed itself for even more spectacular color the following season.
- **Exposure/Soil:** Full sun– part sun. Drought tolerant once established. Needs at least 5 hours afternoon sun. Well-drained soil is essential. Keep water off leaves when watering and prefers to not be watered by sprinklers.
- **Growth:** Moderate, clumping grower to 5 to 7 feet tall, 1 to 2 feet wide.
- **Hardiness:** **Zone 3-8**, Perennial; Reseeds!
- **Foliage:** Deciduous. Foliage features large, heart-shaped (3, 5 or 7 lobes), rough lower leaves which become progressively smaller toward the top of the spire.
- **Flower:** Large, 5" pastel flowers in a mix of beautiful colors cover stately spikes in summer– late fall.
