Alchemilla mollis 'Auslese'

- **Use:** A more upright form of Lady's Mantle, the flower arrangers' favorite ground cover. Tough and adaptable, happy in sun or shade, the foliage captures individual water droplets after the lightest shower. An almost perfect plant in combination with a variety of colors. The leaves and flowers can be used in flower arrangements.
- **Exposure/Soil:** Tolerates sun or shade but best in half day sun here in the South. Prefers evenly moist soil. Please amend the red clay.
- **Growth:** Grows 12-16" tall and 20" wide.
- **Hardiness:** Zone 3-8; Perennial.
- **Foliage:** Deciduous. Grey-green, neatly scalloped leaves catch rain drops and morning dew, which appear like glistening beads
- **Flower:** Flowers are frothy clusters of greenish yellow that appear in early summer.
