Alocasia macrorrhizos 'Portoradora'

- **Use:** 'Sumo' is a hybrid between Alocasia 'Portora' and 'Purple Cloak'. We highly recommend it in your garden for its vigorous nature and commanding presence. The thick green leaves remain attractive the whole summer long.
- **Exposure/Soil:** Full sun– shade, very easy to please. Provide well-drained, moist soil, but not soggy. Use a slow release fertilizer. Always hungry this plant loves lots of water and fertilizer!
- **Growth:** This easy grower reaches 5-6' the first year and 8-10' tall by the second year.
- **Hardiness:** Zone 7b-10, perennial Mulch around the base of the plant 1– 2 ft in the fall. They love wet summers, but good winter drainage is important.
- **Foliage:** Deciduous; The dark, upward-pointing, green leaves are huge – up to 3-4' long when fully mature – and they reach 2.5' across. The back sides of the leaves are light green with purple veins and highlights. The dark leaf stems are reddish-black.
- **Flower:** Not known for their flowers.
