

# Hot Pink Ginger



**Very easy to grow! Lush tropical look with spicy scented leaves when touched!**

## ***Alpinia purpurata 'Hot Pink'***

- **Use:** Ever been frustrated that flower bouquets die so quickly? No fear, the Hot Pink Ginger is here. The Hot Pink's beautiful, tropical flowers can last up to 3 weeks when cut. Great patio and container plant. Add a tropical touch to your garden!
- **Exposure/Soil:** - Grows best in some light shade. Keep soil moist, but good drainage is important.
- **Growth:** Can grow 5-6 feet tall and wide in shade.
- **Hardiness:** Zones 9-11 ; Tropical/ Bring inside in winter.
- **Foliage:** Deciduous. Dark green leaves smell spicy when touched.
- **Flower:** Large clusters of pink flowers that graduate to light pink at the very top on stalks that are 6-12" long.
