

Perennial Japanese Anemone



Compact, upright plants have double, rich pink blooms with yellow stamens. Heavier blooming than taller Japanese varieties, it flowers late summer- fall.

Anemone hupehensis 'Pretty Lady Julia'

- **Use:** Compact in nature, these are great fall flowering plants for the front of the border. Attractive in fall containers and as showy garden border plants.
- **Exposure/Soil:** Prefers part shade, but will tolerate full sun with supplemental watering. Use slow release or water soluble fertilizer. Keep soil moist watering under leaves and flowers for best results.
- **Growth:** Grows 16" tall, and 20" wide.
- **Hardiness:** Zone 5-9 perennial. Very easy to grow!
- **Foliage:** Has 'dark as night' foliage with gorgeously scalloped leaves. Many winters it will be evergreen, but in a cold winter may go dormant.
- **Flower:** Double, 2" pink flowers with a bright yellow center. Flowers late summer through fall. Attractive, cottony seed heads follow.
