
## Perennial Japanese Anemone



Compact, upright plants have double, rich pink blooms with yellow stamens. Heavier blooming than taller Japanese varieties, it flowers late summer- fall.





## Anemone hupehensis 'Pretty Lady Julia'

- <u>Use:</u> Compact in nature, these are great fall flowering plants for the front of the border. Attractive in fall containers and as as showy garden border plants.
- <u>Exposure/Soil</u>: Prefers part shade, but will tolerate full sun with supplemental watering. Use slow release or water soluble fertilizer. Keep soil moist watering under leaves and flowers for best results.
- Growth: Grows 16" tall, and 20" wide.
- Hardiness: Zone 5-9 perennial. Very easy to grow!
- <u>Foliage</u>: Has 'dark as night' foliage with gorgeously scalloped leaves. Many winters it will be evergreen, but in a cold winter may go dormant.
- <u>Flower:</u> Double, 2" pink flowers with a bright yellow center. Flowers late summer through fall. **Attractive, cottony seed heads follow.**
