

Fantasy Red Ridinghood Anemone



Anemone hupehensis 'Fantasy Red Ridinghood'

- **Use:** This new thickly petaled, single flowered rosey pink selection is vigorous, filling pots quickly. Covered in blooms from late July to October, this new selection is a gardener's dream with its many flowers and strong, upright stems.
- **Exposure/Soil:** Prefers part shade, but will tolerate full sun with supplemental watering. Use slow release or water soluble fertilizer. Keep soil moist watering under leaves and flowers for best results.
- **Growth:** Moderate growing; reaches 12 to 18 in. tall, 18 to 24 in. wide.
- **Hardiness:** Zone 5-9 perennial. Very easy to grow!
- **Foliage:** Deciduous; Green foliage is a great backdrop for the flowers.
- **Flower:** Has a single flower in shades of dark, reddish pink, all the better to wow you. It comes into bloom in late summer through autumn, joining its sister varieties in being the perfect fall color infusion for a fading border. The seed heads look like little fluffy cotton balls, standing atop strong stems to give interest to the garden from fall into winter.
