Spring Beauty™ Pink Anemone



This is a great plant for the woodland edge, and all along the middle of any mixed border or sunny foundation planting.





Anemone sylvestris 'Spring Beauty Pink'

- <u>Use:</u> A brand new, pink hybrid selection with flowers that resemble those of Anemone sylvestris. Spring Beauty Pink is perfectly pink and beckons you for a walk outside in your garden in late spring and early summer. Delicate looking, but super sturdy, the bubblegum pink flowers flutter in the wind and stand straight and tall, welcoming early pollinators to their nectar.
- <u>Exposure/Soil</u>: In cooler climates, they can be grown in full sun if a consistent supply of moisture is available, but here in warmer zones, they need protection from the hot, midday sun; dappled shade (especially in the afternoon) is ideal. Use slow release or water soluble fertilizer. Plant them in rich, loose, well-drained soil. Dry or excessively wet soil and windy conditions are a sure downfall of this plant. Always best to water under leaves. Mulch around roots in summer to keep cool.
- <u>Growth</u>: Growing only 10-12" tall and 15" wide makes the compact plant perfect for smaller gardens, and for the front of the border. It spreads by underground rhizomes and can be used as a ground cover.
- <u>Hardiness</u>: Zone 4-8; Perennial. Very easy to grow!
- **Foliage:** Deciduous; Tough, lacy, green foliage is a great backdrop for the flowers.
- <u>Flower:</u> This spring-blooming Anemone is covered with rosy pink flowers. They look dainty, but looks can be deceiving. These sturdy blooms stand up to the wind, as well as to enthusiastic pollinators who visit for beneficial nectar. Sterile flowers.
