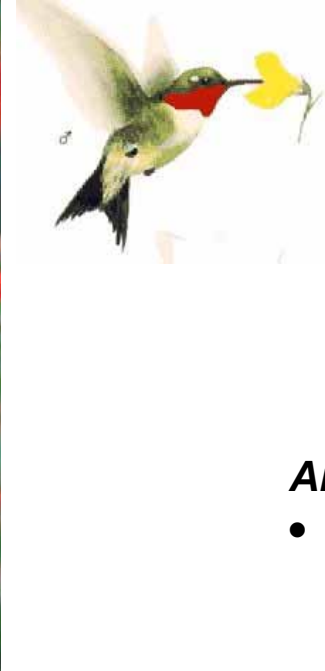


Flame Acanthus



Anisacanthus wrightii 'Flame'

- **Use:** A tough, native 3' shrubby perennial covered with bright orange tubular flowers steadily all summer into fall. Sun. Hummingbirds & Butterflies! Extremely drought tolerant. Excellent for perennial borders, and containers. Resistant to heat, drought and humidity.
- **Exposure/Soil:** Plant in full sun to partial sun. Use slow release or water soluble fertilizer. Keep soil moist watering under leaves and flowers for best results. Drought tolerant once established.
- **Growth:** Fast growing to 3' tall and 3' wide.
- **Hardiness:** 6-9 perennial. Very heat tolerant! Mulch around plant in the winter.
- **Foliage:** Deciduous.
- **Flower:** Bright orange tubular flowers are loved by hummingbirds and butterflies.
