Aquilegia chrysantha

- **Use:** An upright plant just right for the shady perennial border, patio, woodland plantings, or accents. Columbines are one of the easiest and most rewarding of all perennials. Their flowers are a treasure in spring and when they are through flowering their waxy green foliage continues to add grace to the garden.
- **Exposure/Soil:** Part sun– shade. Provide well-drained, moist soil, but not soggy. Use a slow release fertilizer.
- **Growth:** Grows quickly 24-30” tall and wide
- **Hardiness:** 3-9; Perennial
- **Foliage:** Deciduous. Trternate, almost fern-like, basal green foliage with a bluish tinge.
- **Flower:** Features large, upward facing, fragrant, bright yellow flowers with long, outward curving spurs in spring.
